




# Building a Strong Future with OIL & GAS TAX REVENUE

North Dakota receives revenue from the state's oil and gas production through an oil & gas gross production tax (5%) and an oil extraction tax (5%). The state expects to generate \$2.4 billion from these taxes during the 2015-2017 biennium. In 2013, the State Legislature established an allocation plan for these funds. The numbers here reflect the projected allocations.
