

On February 3rd, the Census Bureau released its annual report on computer and internet use based on data collected from in the Current Population Survey in October of 2012. The percentage of residents with computer access was listed for each state.

In North Dakota an estimated 84.0 percent of households have internet access compared 79.3 percent for the United States. North Dakota ranked 12th highest of the 50 states in households have internet access. In the reign North Dakota only trails Minnesota that ranked 3rd highest. North Dakota's ranking climbed dramatically from the prior year, when it ranked 29th of the 50 states and was tied with the U.S. average.
